WELCOME TO OUR MONTHLY NEWSLETTER

A. FINANCIAL REPORT – General fund total - \$450,813. Reserve fund total - \$282,499. Expenses for the month of May - \$54,394. Income/Deposits for the month of May - \$66,732. Delinquent dues - We have 37 members in collections.

B. LOT SALES – We had 0 properties sold in May.

C. ELECTION – The upcoming MSFPOA Director Election this fall will have 3 open seats. It's very important that everyone vote in this election. The election will be by mail and it is imperative that everyone vote so that we have the quorum needed to make the election valid.

D. FIRE SAFETY – We are once again in a drought YEAR. Please remember to clear your property for fire safety. There is to be absolutely NO burning in the MSFPOA. Please note: 1 fire has already been put out by Cal Fire in our forest.

E. CC&R COMMITTEE – We have completed our meetings where the Board, the Association's Attorney and the final three of five volunteer members had met updating the 1966, CC&R's to the current laws. The final draft will be forthcoming to all members.

F. ADDRESSES - It is important that the office have every member's current address and information. Please, if you have had an address change, notify the office so that you will continue to receive any important information by mail.

G. ANNUAL MSFPOA PICNIC – The 2021 Annual Picnic date is Saturday, August 7, 2021 at 11:00 am, at the MSFPOA Hose Company's "outdoor picnic area". We are bringing back the "The Old Man Jam Band" for all to enjoy.

H. ROADS – Road work has started in the forest, please drive with care. Remember the speed limit is 25 MPH on the chip sealed roads and 15 MPH on all dirt roads, to help keep down the dust as well as damage to our roads. It should also be noted that if someone is purposely damaging our roads, the cost of repair will be on the property owner.

I. BOARD MEETING – The next Board Meeting will be determined by the final draft of the CC&R's.

All meetings are always posted on the office door, the MSFPOA kiosk, and on the MSFPOA Facebook page, three (3) days prior to all meetings.

J. MEETINGS - It is very important for all of our members to feel safe and welcome at our meetings. The first two meetings that we have had since the Covid-19 pandemic, both in February and March of 2021, we unfortunately had a member at each meeting become verbally abusive and volatile, causing our members stress and concern. This unacceptable behavior will not be tolerated and should it happen again at any meeting, the meeting will be adjourned immediately.

DUE TO COVID RESTRICTIONS REMAINING IN PLACE FOR SO LONG, WHICH WAS UNFORSEEN BY THE BOARD, THE BOARD CAN NO LONGER POSTPONE THE BUSINESS OF THE ASSOCIATION. THEREFORE, STARTING IMMEDIATELY AND UNTIL COVID RESTRICTIONS ARE LIFTED ENTIRELY, ALL OPEN BOARD MEETINGS WILL BE RESTRICTED TO THE BOARD PLUS 24 MEMBER ATTENDEES. WHILE EVERYONE IS WELCOME, IF MORE THAN 24 MEMBERS ATTEMPT TO ATTEND, THE MEETING WILL BE SUSPENDED BY THE BOARD AND RE-NOTICED AS A ZOOM MEETING AT A SUBSTANTIAL EXPENSE TO THE ASSOCIATION. WE DON'T WANT TO DISCOURAGE ANYONE FROM ATTENDING, BUT IF ONE PERSON PER HOUSEHOLD COULD ATTEND, IT WOULD BE HELPFUL AS WE TRY TO DEAL WITH COVID RESTRICTIONS.

ALL MEMBERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO WEAR MASKS AND SOCIAL DISTANCE. UPON ENTERING, ALL ATTENDEES WILL HAVE THEIR TEMPERATURES TAKEN, GIVEN A MASK (IF NEEDED) AND HAND SANITIZER WILL BE AVAILABLE.

****PLEASE NOTE** PER THE SISKIYOU COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT, SHOULD YOUR TEMPERATURE BE 100.0 OR HIGHER AT THE DOOR, WE WILL RESPECTFULLY ASK THAT YOU DO NOT ATTEND THE MEETING AS A PRECAUTION AND SAFETY TO OUR MEMBERS. THANK YOU FOR YOUR UNDERSTANDING.**
